HISTORIC HOMES IN WILKES

QUICK ANSWER: WHERE DO YOU FIND HISTORIC HOMES IN WILKES COUNTY?

In Wilkes County, historic homes are commonly found in **older in-town neighborhoods near Wilkesboro and North Wilkesboro**, plus scattered **farmhouses, estates, and landmark properties** throughout the county. Two key historic “cores” include:

- **Downtown Wilkesboro Historic District** (National Register) Wilkesboro NC Government
- **Downtown Main Street Historic District (North Wilkesboro)** (National Register) North Carolina Files

And if a property is inside Wilkesboro’s **local** historic district, exterior changes may be regulated by **local ordinance** and reviewed by the Historic Preservation Commission. Wilkesboro NC Government / American Legal Publishing

HISTORIC DISTRICT VS “HISTORIC FEEL” (THIS MATTERS BEFORE YOU BUY)

NATIONAL REGISTER LISTED (RECOGNITION)

Wilkes has National Register districts including **Downtown Wilkesboro** and **Downtown Main Street (North Wilkesboro)**. eFOTG / Wilkesboro NC Government

National Register listing is primarily **recognition** (and can support eligibility for certain incentives depending on property type and project), but it’s different from local regulation.

LOCAL HISTORIC DISTRICT (RULES CAN APPLY)

Wilkesboro specifically notes the **Historic Downtown Wilkesboro District** is listed on the National Register **and also regulated by local ordinance** through its Historic Preservation Commission. Wilkesboro NC Government

Translation: two homes can both be “historic,” but only one might require approvals for exterior changes. We help you verify this early so you don’t get surprised.

WHERE TO LOOK FOR HISTORIC HOMES (WILKES COUNTY “ZONES”)

1) WILKESBORO HISTORIC CORE (DOWNTOWN WILKESBORO HISTORIC DISTRICT)

The Downtown Wilkesboro Historic District is centered around the Main/Bridge Street area and includes a large collection of historic resources. Wilkesboro NC Government

Best for: buyers who want walkable-town energy, classic architecture, and that “main street” charm.

2) NORTH WILKESBORO HISTORIC CORE (DOWNTOWN MAIN STREET HISTORIC DISTRICT)

North Wilkesboro's Downtown Main Street Historic District is a recognized historic commercial core laid out in a grid pattern, centered along Main Street. North Carolina Files

****Best for:**** buyers who love being near local shops, older streetscapes, and community events.

3) COUNTYWIDE HISTORIC PROPERTIES (FARMHOUSES, LANDMARKS, AND "ONE-OF-A-KIND" HOMES)

Wilkes County has numerous individual historic properties listed on the National Register in addition to the districts. Wikipedia

A fun "history anchor" for the area is the ****Wilkes Heritage Museum****, which has restored and preserves sites like the ****Old Wilkes County Jail**** and the ****1779 Captain Robert Cleveland home****, along with other historic structures. Wilkes Heritage Museum / Blue Ridge Heritage

****Best for:**** buyers who want acreage + historic character (and don't mind verifying wells/septic, access, and renovation scope).

RENOVATING A HISTORIC HOME IN WILKES COUNTY (WHAT TO VERIFY)

If the property is in Wilkesboro's locally regulated historic district, Wilkesboro provides ****design guidelines**** intended to guide exterior changes and support review decisions. Wilkesboro NC Government

SMART QUESTIONS TO ASK EARLY

- Is this home in a ****locally regulated**** historic district (rules) or only ****National Register**** (recognition)? Wilkesboro NC Government
- What changes need review (windows, roofing material, siding, paint colors, porch alterations, fences, outbuildings)? Wilkesboro NC Government
- Were major renovations permitted and properly documented?

- Electrical (panel capacity, wiring type)
- Plumbing type + condition
- Roof age + flashing details
- HVAC age / ducting
- Insulation and windows (comfort + energy use)

- Evidence of prior water intrusion

PAPERWORK PRIORITIES

- Any permits for additions/renovations
- Whether the property sits in a regulated district (if applicable) Wilkesboro NC Government
- Renovation guidelines if the district is regulated Wilkesboro NC Government
