W KERR SCOTT LAKE LIVING GUIDE

QUICK ANSWER: WHAT IS W. KERR SCOTT LAKE KNOWN FOR?

W. Kerr Scott Lake (W. Kerr Scott Dam & Reservoir) is a **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers** lake near Wilkesboro with **boating, kayaking, fishing, swimming beaches, campgrounds, and an incredible trail system**—including nationally recognized historic trail segments and **40+ miles of mountain bike singletrack**. National Park Service

1) W. KERR SCOTT LAKE BASICS (WHAT IT IS + WHERE IT IS)

- Operated by the **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE)**, primarily for **flood control and water supply**, with recreation as a major benefit. Saw
- The reservoir is about **1,475 acres at normal pool**, and the shoreline is about **56 miles** (shoreline is managed under a Shoreline Management Plan). Saw
- The dam is located roughly **4 miles west of Wilkesboro** (so you get “lake life” without feeling remote). Saw

2) THE BIG “LAKEFRONT TRUTH” IN NC: SHORELINE RULES + DOCK PERMITS

If you’re buying “on the lake,” this is the part that protects you. USACE manages shoreline use through a **Shoreline Management Plan** designed to balance private use with public access and environmental protection. The shoreline is classified into areas like **Public Recreation, Protected Shoreline, Limited Development, and Prohibited Access**—and private facilities are generally only possible in certain zones with permits. Saw

WHAT THAT MEANS FOR BUYERS

- A home can be **near the water** but not automatically eligible for a private dock.
- **Vegetation clearing** and shoreline changes may be limited or require approval. Saw
- USACE has a **permit process** and shoreline contacts (often handled through the Shoreline Ranger). Saw

3) RECREATION GUIDE (WHAT YOU CAN DO AT THE LAKE)

W. Kerr Scott is one of those rare lakes where you can truly build a lifestyle around the outdoors.

WATER FUN

- **Boat ramps:** USACE notes **seven boat ramps**. Saw
- **Swim beaches:** USACE lists **three public swim beaches**. Saw
- **Fishing:** USACE highlights species like bass and catfish and calls out strong angling opportunities. Saw

TRAILS (THIS IS A BIG DEAL HERE)

- USACE promotes **40+** miles of singletrack for mountain biking. Saw
- The lake area includes segments connected to the **Overmountain Victory National Historic Trail**, with NPS noting **11** miles of certified trail at the reservoir. National Park Service

CAMPING + DAY USE

- USACE lists **3** campgrounds and provides seasonal windows (varies by campground). Saw
- You can reserve camping and facilities through **Recreation.gov**. Recreation.gov

4) BOATING & SAFETY (SIMPLE, HELPFUL, NOT OVERWHELMING)

North Carolina boating rules apply, and certain areas around structures can have restrictions.

- NC Wildlife's **Personal Watercraft (PWC/Jet Ski) law** includes no-wake buffers near people, docks, and vessels. NC Wildlife
- There are also state regulatory rules for "no wake" zones in specific regulated areas around the Kerr Scott Dam/structures (outlined in NC administrative code). NCOA Hearings Reports
- **Easy tip:** If you're buying for boating, we'll show you how to choose the right side of the lake for your preferred activity (quiet coves vs open water access).

5) "REAL LIFE" LAKE LIVING: WHAT HOMES FEEL LIKE AROUND KERR SCOTT

Most buyers near W. Kerr Scott Lake want one of these lifestyles:

1) FULL-TIME "PEACE + PROXIMITY"

- You want privacy, trees, and water nearby—but still quick access to Wilkesboro/North Wilkesboro.

2) WEEKEND HOME / SECOND HOME

- You want easy trail access, kayaking, and a place to unplug.

3) LAND + CABINS VISION

- Larger tracts near the reservoir (not necessarily "lakefront") can be ideal—but shoreline access and dock rights must be verified under USACE rules. Saw

6) HOW TO CHECK WATER LEVEL (BECAUSE IT MATTERS)

Water levels can change based on season, rain, and operations.

- USACE provides **current pool elevation** updates online. Water Data
- USGS also maintains monitoring data for the reservoir location. USGS Water Data

Yes—"lake" is the common name, while the official name is ****W. Kerr Scott Dam & Reservoir****. It's operated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Saw

CAN I BUILD A DOCK ON W. KERR SCOTT LAKE?

Sometimes—but not always. USACE manages the shoreline under a Shoreline Management Plan and permits are required. We help you confirm this for the exact address. Saw

WHAT CAN YOU DO AT W. KERR SCOTT LAKE?

Boating, fishing, swimming beaches, camping, picnic areas, and a major trail system (including extensive mountain bike trails). Saw

HOW DO I CHECK LAKE WATER LEVELS?

USACE posts current pool elevation data online, and USGS also provides monitoring data. Water Data
