IF YOU LOVE CHARACTER + HISTORIC CHARM

Winston-Salem has some beautiful older neighborhoods with architecture and personality—just know older homes come with unique quirks.

- Best for: charm-lovers, history lovers, walkable vibes

IF YOU WANT NEW CONSTRUCTION + MODERN LAYOUTS

Newer builds can be great for low-maintenance living, but location varies—some new construction is in established areas, while some is further out.

- Best for: buyers who want fresh + functional
